TB Risk Screening Electronic Form

Required for all students.

Completed online by a student at pba.medicatconnect.com.

If the student answers YES to any of the questions on the TB Risk Screening, a TB Clinical Assessment must be completed by a physician. Submit TB test results, if required.

Immunization Form

Required for all Full-Time Day Undergraduate students: MMR1 & MMR2. Additional requirements if living on campus: Hep B 1, Hep B 2, Hep B 3, Meningococcal (ACWY) Completed by a physician. Must have office stamp. We will also accept other official immunization records. Please print, have the physician complete, and submit online at pba.medicatconnect.com. *School of Nursing, School of Pharmacy, and Athletic Training may have additional requirements.

Physical Form

Required for all Full-Time Day Undergraduate students. Completed by a physician in the last 12 months. Must have office stamp. Please print, have the physician complete, and submit online at pba.medicatconnect.com.

Student Health Insurance

PBA requires all UNDERGRADUATE students taking 9 or more credit hours, all full-time GRADUATE students taking 6 or more credit hours, and all Ph.D. students taking 3 or more credit hours, as well as all International, Pharmacy, Nursing, and full-time Evening students to have health insurance. These students will be automatically billed and enrolled in the PBA Student Health Insurance Plan unless a waiver is submitted before the posted deadline. Students enrolled in Online Programs are not eligible to enroll in this insurance plan and do NOT have to submit a waiver.
